In spite of recent flood disasters across the nation, many Americans are not adequately prepared to respond to a flood event. If you think you're not at risk, consider these eye-opening facts.

IN THE U.S. – CLAIMS AVERAGE NEARLY \$4 BILLION PER YEAR.**

27X Higher risk
than fire

During a **30-year** mortgage period you are **27 times** more likely to experience a flood than fire.

New land development can increase flood risk, especially if the construction changes natural runoff paths.



Flash floods often bring walls of water **10-15 feet high**. Even the strongest swimmers cannot swim through the force of flash flood.



ALL 50 STATES HAVE EXPERIENCED FLOODS OR FLASH FLOODS

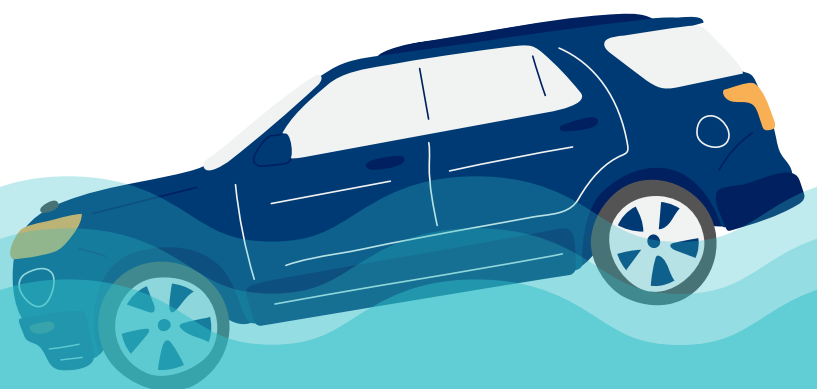


Water can rise and eliminate your escape route in a matter of minutes.

More than half of flood-related fatalities happen in cars as a result of drivers mis-judging the depth of water and the force of moving water on the road.
